

DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY TO EU DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU (RoHS) AND DELEGATED DIRECTIVE 2015/863/EU

AXTAL GmbH is aware that the EU Directive 2011/65/EU ("RoHS 2") and its Amendment Delegated Directive 2015/863/EU are limiting the use of certain hazardous substances in electric and electronic equipment.


In particular the following substances are listed

1. Lead (0.1 %)
2. Mercury (0.1 %)
3. Cadmium (0.01 %)
4. Hexavalent Chromium (0.1 %)
5. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
6. Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
7. Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
8. Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
9. Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
10. Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

The following statement regarding conformity of our products to the EU Directives 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU is based on our actual research and inquiries with our suppliers:

- The shares of above-mentioned substances in our products are not exceeding the limits as defined in the RoHS Directive
- AXTAL GmbH is systematically using lead-free soldering metals, unless specific customer requirements are asking for other, lead-containing soldering metals
- AXTAL GmbH is in the position, upon customer request, to propose and provide products using lead-containing soldering metals
- The RoHS status of our products is listed on data sheets or in the documentation accompanying the shipment.
